From its humble beginnings, NWCF has worked tirelessly to connect the community to children in need by funding programs that help end the cycle of child abuse and neglect. **Since 1985, NWCF has carefully awarded nearly 10 million donor dollars in over 900 grants to 300 of the Northwest's most effective social service agencies.**

These figures are encouraging, but they become even more inspiring when you consider how funding has translated into lives touched and forever changed. At the NWCF Benefit Auction and Dinner last May, single mother Brenda Lopez spoke of her upbringing and the abuse, neglect, drug use and poverty that plagued her life for decades. With continued support from a myriad of social service agencies, she was finally able to break the cycle of child abuse and neglect, and be the kind of mother she always wished she could be. She is quick to give credit to Northwest Children's Fund for supporting exactly the types of organizations she needed to succeed.

Brenda is living proof that child abuse and neglect is treatable and preventable. The cycle can be broken; it just takes a strong network of support. Northwest Children's Fund is proud to be an integral part of this network—and we look ahead to a fantastic year of celebrating the generous donors, diligent Board members, outstanding social service agencies, and brave children and families who share our mission: to end the cycle of child abuse and neglect, and give children the safe, healthy childhoods they deserve.

# 25 Years of Connecting Our Community With Children in Need

In 1985, four women were inspired to create something new and special in Seattle: an organization devoted to helping children in need, and to growing social service philanthropy among their peers. They researched, recruited friends and in May 1985, a founding Board of Directors of 26 men and women created Northwest Children's Fund – an organization that links the compassion and generosity of community donors to the needs of our most vulnerable kids.

NWCF's first benefit auction surpassed expectations, enabling the new organization to make grants totaling \$32,000. Our first grants were awarded to Childhaven, the Committee for Children, and Seattle Youth and Community Services (now known as YouthCare).

In the ensuing quarter century, NWCF has matured into a respected part of the children's funding landscape, and a preferred method for many Northwest donors to make smart and meaningful investments in our community's most vulnerable children.

**Mission:** To end the cycle of child abuse and neglect by supporting programs for at-risk children and their families.

**Vision:** To be the most effective funder of private contributions to child welfare in Western Washington.

**Fundraising** – As a vital vehicle for community investment in child welfare, NWCF will aim to increase our grant distributions each year through growth in donor contributions.

**Grantmaking** – Through a discriminating grant review process, ongoing board education, and incorporation of best practices and available research on child welfare, NWCF will strive for ever-improving effectiveness in grantmaking.

**Organizational Development** – NWCF will seek to recruit, educate and retain compassionate board members and employees of the highest quality, in order to achieve greater impact through fun and engaged teamwork.

**Stewardship** – Through efficient allocation of funds, complete and accurate reporting, and conscientious application of governance policies, NWCF will work to remain a community leader in financial stewardship.

**Awareness** – NWCF will commit to increasing awareness of child welfare issues and solutions in our community, and of NWCF's role in funding solutions.

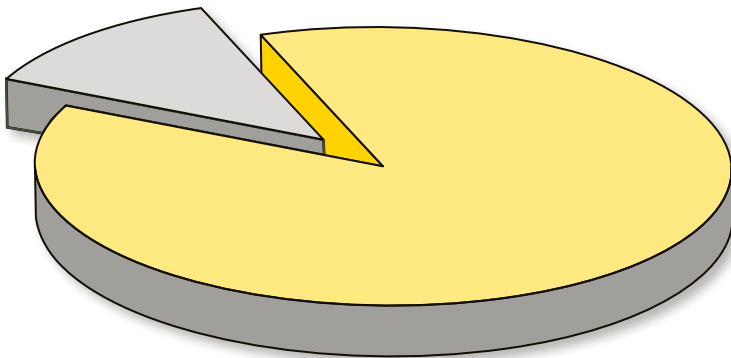

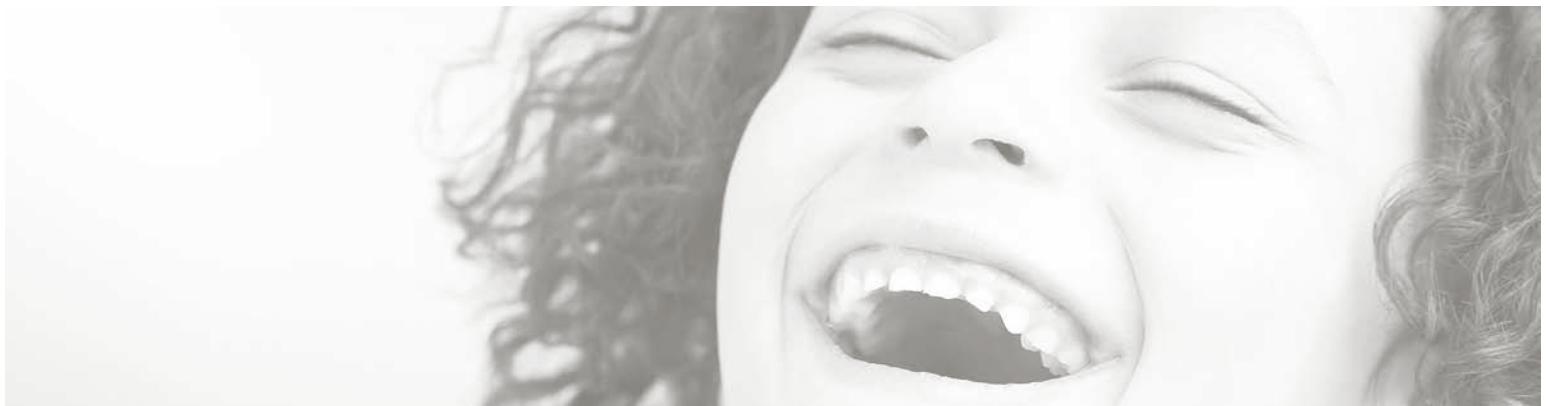
